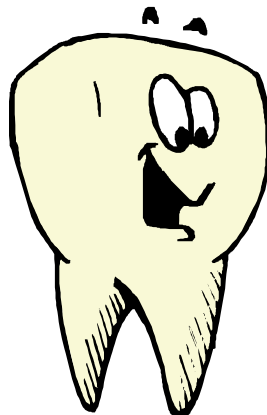

4. Do not eat too many sweets.

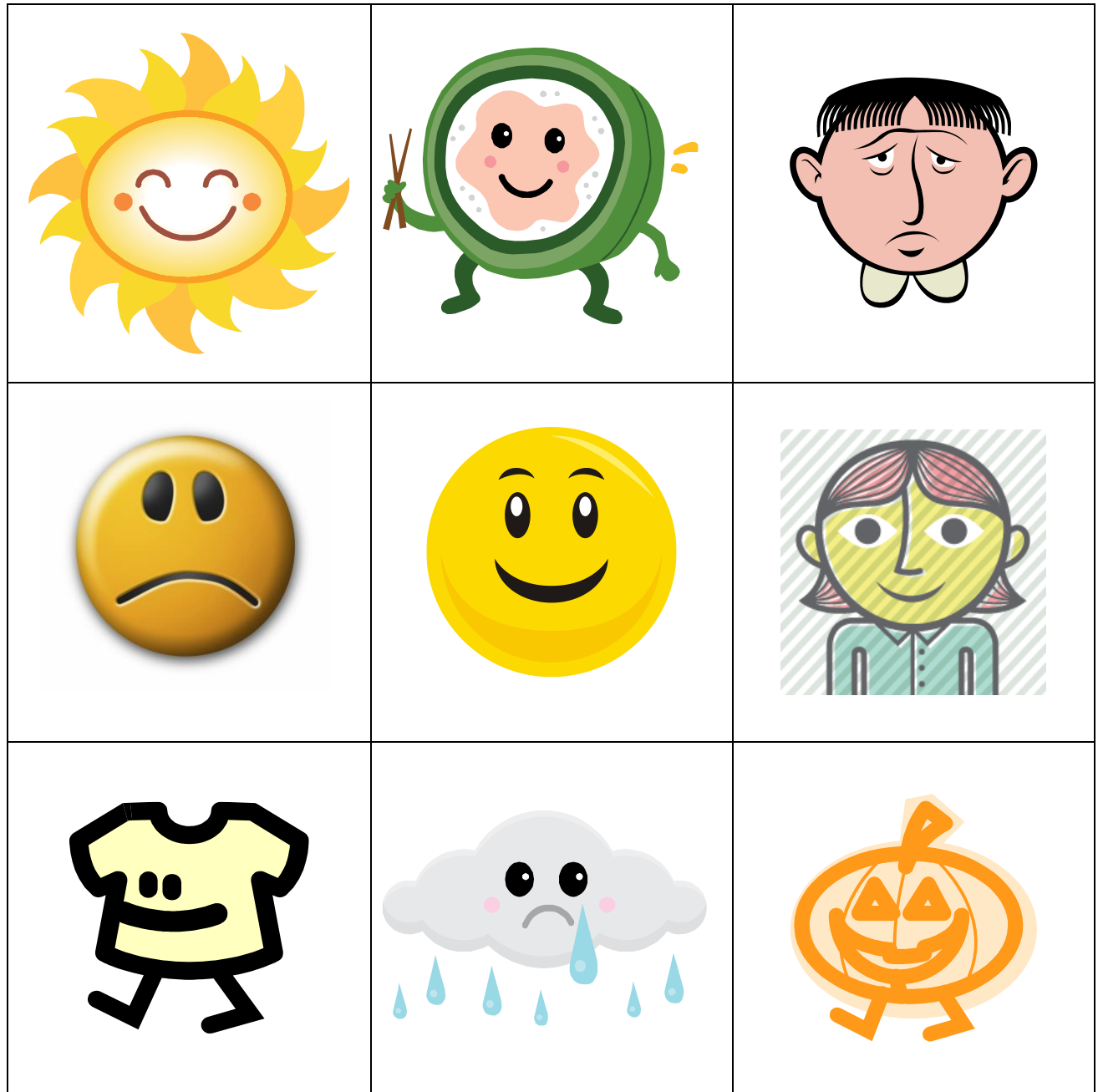
